From Your Interim Pastor:

Hard to believe that school is starting and fall is upon us. Back in March when we called a halt to our normal operations, I don't think any of us thought it would go on this long. But we've adapted to a new normal which continues to evolve. Even as we cannot see the end yet, your church leaders are beginning to think of how we can function in a more robust manner. Restaurants are beginning to function with new guidelines, so maybe we will find ways to enjoy that men's fish fry and women's spaghetti dinner. With adjustments we are planning a "trunk or treat" event for our children. And whether we use Zoom or socially distanced gatherings for Bible study and other meetings---life needs to go on.

Last May I began proposing some ideas to the council for your next permanent pastoral leadership. It has taken a few months for conversations to begin, but at the August meeting council members had a good discussion which begins what will likely be a lengthy process. Our new bishop begins her new position in September so she currently feels like she's drinking from a large firehose, but before long she will be able to assist us in the process. We don't want to rush things as this would be a very difficult time to transition to a new leader. As your interim pastor, I will continue to provide guidance for the council and service to the congregation for the foreseeable future.

But now, I'd like to invite all your creative thinking. As we move into fall and winter, celebrating the holidays and continuing as church will require adjustments to keep us all safe. But as we're learning more about this disease and becoming more accustomed to the required precautions, let's all try to imagine what we are able to do. We're looking for your ideas and creativity----maybe

to start new traditions even as we hope for an end to this plague. Talk to your leaders. Send any of us an email. We need all our best thinking to be the church in this unusual time.

Finally, I want to give thanks that everyone has seemed to stay safe. We are all suffering some kind of virus weariness or depression. While Georgia and I have been making the best of it, we have now cancelled or postponed a number of planned travels and activities. We're hoping to at least visit Georgia's 96-year-old father and other family in September----but it's been tough----and even when we do travel, it will be with special precautions. We need to help one another as this continues. Keep up those contacts. Remember that the building may be closed, but the church is still open! We are the church to one another and our community.

August Council meeting notes: 08-9-2020

Doug Lindstrom opened the meeting with prayer.

- As part of Pastor Craig's report he indicated that he's begun to think of our services as we approach the holiday season with the Covid-19 virus still present.
- The next Red Cross blood drive at Good Shepherd will be on Monday, September 14. There will be another blood drive on Thursday, September 24, in memory of Marshall Catterton. Council approved three dates for blood drives for January, March and May of 2021.
- There will be a Congregational meeting on Sunday, August 30, following worship to vote on the replacement of the parsonage roof. The roof was damaged by wind in April, and an insurance claim was paid, but our church constitution requires congregational approval of the project because the amount of the contract is greater than 3% of our approved Spending Plan.
- Council members had a brief conversation regarding other repairs needed on the parsonage.
- Council began conversations with Pastor Craig regarding the call process.

Pastor Craig closed the meeting with prayer.

Financial Corner:


