

From Your Interim Pastor :

Easter always brings hope, but maybe this year more than normal. The slowness of spring 2021 seems to mimic the gradual, ever so slow decline of the coronavirus. We associate Easter with all things in bloom and perhaps this year the azaleas have even delayed to be able to help us celebrate. Having spent 36 years in Minnesota, it was fairly common there to even still have snow on the ground this time of the year. But in the low country, it seems all of nature gives testimony to the resurrection and new life. It's curious to me why some people so insistently doubt the resurrection when all around us there are signs of new life.

Some of the new life at Good Shepherd can be seen in two adult baptisms this Easter, four confirmations in May, the return of the Lutheroad Day Camp for kids this summer, and the gradual opening up of more activities. In March the congregation voted to replace the heating and air conditioning units in the worship center----another sign of confidence in the future of our church.

In the months ahead the council will start more active considerations of our future ministry. Determining our future path may take some time, but as the virus subsides, we're ready to look forward with hope. The synod has offered a number of tools for guidance. Before long Bishop Aebisher will be meeting with our leadership and then with the whole congregation.

In the meantime I will continue to provide pastoral leadership. I'm optimistic that visitation and several of our activities can begin to move toward normalcy. Most of all, I encourage you to get the vaccinations to help move us toward all that we desire. Easter is a time of resurrection----not just for a day, but as a new season. I think we're all more than ready.

March Council meeting notes : 3-14-2021

Kathie opened the meeting with devotionals.

- 1. Council approved the recommendation from the Property Committee to award the contract to replace both HVAC units in the sanctuary to Snelgrove's HVAC and to fund that project from the Wallace Fund. The congregational meeting to act on the Council recommendation is scheduled for March 21 following worship.
- 2. Property Committee chair, Carl Lindstrom, reported that the Committee will be bringing a checklist on proposed parsonage repairs to the next Council meeting.
- 3. Pastor Craig informed the Council that we will be celebrating two Baptisms on Easter Sunday and four Confirmations on Pentecost Sunday.
- 4. Pastor Craig also reported that Bishop Ginny Aebischer is holding a virtual meeting with Interim Pastors in the SC Synod to discuss a new transition process for calling a new Pastor or Deacon to a congregation. After that meeting, Pastor will discuss the document with the Executive Committee.
- 5. Amy reported that the Red Cross blood drive on March 8 resulted in 64 units of blood collected. Thanks to Doug L, Kathie and Diane for volunteering at the Blood Drive.
- 6. Amy also brought reports from the Christian Ed, WELCA, and Worship and Music meetings.
- 7. A sub-committee of the Council is working on policies for our current Social Ministry program and the newly founded Lommen Love Fund and will bring an update on those to the next Council meeting.
- 8. Doug Lindstrom reported on the status of the Food Pantry and asked for volunteers to assist in various responsibilities of that ministry.
- 9. Kevin reported that the new laptop computer has arrived and is being used for our Zoom worship services.
- 10. Council approved a request from the family of Mary Lommen to use the church and fellowship hall on Thursday, June 24, for a Celebration of Life for Mrs. Mary.

There being no other business, Pastor Craig closed the meeting with prayer. The next Council meeting will be on Sunday, April 11, at 5:00 via Zoom.


