From the Pastor:

As we enter the summer months, we have much to be thankful for. In May we elected a call committee and enjoyed a visit from our new bishop. While she was with us, Bishop Ginny met with our council and call committee to outline the next steps and begin our formal search process. When Georgia and I had lunch with her, she had very positive things to say about the progress we are making. But we have major challenges and decisions to make as we move forward.

Sometime in late June or early July the entire congregation will be asked to participate in a Congregational Vitality Survey. The survey comes out of Baylor University and provides significant insights into the workings of our church. Later this summer Bishop Assistant Carter will bring the results to us. At the same time, we're beginning work on the Congregational Ministry Profile. This is the document that will be shared with future prospective pastors. A lot of work goes into developing this snapshot of what Good Shepherd is like and what are its hopes and dreams.

One of the big decisions for your leadership is whether Good Shepherd can afford a full-time pastor. The years with your most recent pastor were very difficult financially. Finding someone part time can be even more difficult and requires finding a person who doesn't need full time income or has partial employment from another source. Another option is sharing a pastor with another congregation, but developing that kind of relationship can also be difficult.

Right now, the projected year end income for Good Shepherd is about \$90,000. In order to call someone full time, that number

probably needs to be closer to \$125,000. We have no idea if that's anywhere near realistic, but that will be part of our discussions in the next few months.

The good news is that mission and ministry of Good Shepherd continues. Lutherroad will be returning this summer. We will be blessed to host a celebration of life for Mary and Arden Lommen. I anticipate that continued lowering of virus numbers will allow us to restart a number of in-person activities. I plan to return to spending one day each week in Walterboro calling on members and providing more hands-on presence with the ministry. The pastor's office is being spiffed up with a lovely donated desk, cleaned carpets, and furniture rearranged. Yet to come is painting and some new window treatments. If you're really good at painting, we'd love to hear from you!

I know that summer often offers the opportunity to get away. Georgia and I have a few trips planned including seeing our son in LA---it's been 16 months since we've been together. Wherever you go, do so safely and when you're in town, the church has brand new air conditioning to keep us cool. When you're away, the weekly emails and Zoom recordings can keep you close and in touch. See you often!

Financial Corner

April was another month of generous giving to the ministries of Good Shepherd. However, our spending for the month exceeded our gifts to the ministry due to the unbudgeted expenses of the Fellowship Hall ice maker and the repairs to the church organ. Those two expenses totaled almost \$2,700. The Council's decision to get rid of the ice maker will save us between \$300 and \$350 per year in budgeted funds.


You'll note that we are continuing to pay back the Wallace Fund for the sanctuary ceiling repair and the parsonage heating and air conditioning cost from several years back. With gifts to the Wallace Fund we have reduced that debt to \$8,040. In May, we paid for the heating and air conditioning units replacement in the church. That expense of \$11,200 will also come from the Wallace Fund.

We are thankful for the very generous gift from Bethel Presbyterian for our **Food Pantry**. If you know someone from Bethel please pass along our thanks for being part of this ministry with us.

The Lommen Love Program was established with a gift from the children of Arden and Mary Lommen in loving memory of their parents. This policy seeks to assure that Good Shepherd Lutheran Church is continually working towards providing members and friends alike with care and assistance when funds are available.

The Council met following worship on Sunday, May 16, along with the Call Committee and Bishop Ginny Aebischer.

- 1. Council approved the minutes from the previous meeting, as well as the financial report from April.
- **2.** Amy gave reports on the Christian Education Committee, Worship and Music Committee, WELCA and the recent American Red Cross Blood Drive.
- **3.** Council approved policies for our current Social Ministry program and the newly established Lommen Love Fund.
- **4.** Doug Lindstrom, Kevin Wicker and Pastor Craig will "attend" the 2021 SC Synod Assembly that will take place on Saturday, June 26. This year's Assembly will be held on-line like last year.
- **5.** Council has asked the Worship and Music Committee to review the church Covid policy based on recent changes to the CDC guidelines.
- 6. Bishop Ginny spoke to the Council and Call Committee members about the entire Call Process, and outlined the Congregational Vitality Survey and the Ministry Site Profile. These two documents are the next steps in the Call Process. Council will meet again on Sunday, June 6, following worship for the purpose of working on the Call Process.
