

#### From Your Interim Pastor :

My father-in-law at 98 years old says that if he'd have known he was going to live this long, he would have taken better care of himself! I have similar thoughts about serving as your interim pastor. Typically, an interim pastor serves for a year, maybe as much as 18 months while a church is in process for calling their next pastor. October marks my 36<sup>th</sup> month here at Good Shepherd. Had I known this at the start, I might very well have done some things differently. Of course, this situation is unique. Your council has made the wise decision that you really need (and can afford) a part time pastor. That has made the search far more complicated as synods in this part of the country have had far less experience in placing part time pastors. And I suspect Covid complicated matters even more.

I confess that I have felt bad about the amount of time I've scheduled away from you. All through this interim I've maintained my relationship with St. John's Lutheran in Beaufort, so I am there one Sunday a month and one day each week. Georgia and I have also scheduled a number of trips. We keep thinking our time here will be finished----and we've been wrong several times. In October we're taking a "leaf-peeper" cruise up the New England and Canadian coast. In January we're headed to South Africa for almost 3 weeks. These are "bucket list" travels that we want to do before we're too old to get around. I want to thank you for your understanding and flexibility. I'm very grateful that we have wonderful supply pastors and very competent, caring lay members who look after one another when I'm gone.

Fortunately, the ministries of Good Shepherd continue without a hitch. This month on Reformation Sunday, October 30<sup>th</sup>, we'll

celebrate our 2<sup>nd</sup> confirmation in two years. I hope you'll plan to wear red that day and enjoy a festive day. Many congregations larger than ours aren't as fortunate these days. Then on Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup> the men are doing their annual fish fry. Charles Rister was distributing tickets this past Sunday so be sure you get yours and invite your neighbors and friends to this great fund raiser. Before we know it, the holidays will be here. Thanksgiving comes early this year on November 24<sup>th</sup> and Advent is as long as the season can possibly be. Christmas falls on a Sunday, as does New Year's Day. We'll do our best to have a schedule appropriate for that unusual circumstance. Until then, enjoy the return of cooler weather and the lovely fall season of the Low Country. See you in church!

It's been a busy month on the **Parsonage Project** as we move into the Fall months. Since our last newsletter, the garage walls and floor have been prepped and painted, the garage apron concrete has been pressure washed as well as the sidewalks at the

front and back doors, the garage door remote controls have been replaced, the carpet in the house has been cleaned for assessment, and the sink drains have been cleared. Forthcoming, a decision on the condition of the carpet, the women of Good Shepherd are working on new door curtains, the back storm door will be ordered, and there is limited touch-



up paint to complete. To date, expensed, committed and estimated cost of the parsonage project is \$13,194.



#### September Council meeting notes : 09-11-2022

Amy opened the meeting with prayer and Council approved the minutes of the August meeting as presented by Jon.

- Kevin presented the financial report for August and Year-to-Date followed by the Property report with updates on the progress of the parsonage project. Kevin also informed Council that he is still seeking information regarding a Zoom streaming and audio system for the sanctuary, and he is to meet with City representatives to discuss mitigating the magnolia tree between the breezeway and the parsonage.
- Amy reminded everyone that the Red Cross Blood Mobile would be at Good Shepherd the following day, and presented reports from Christian Education, WELCA, LMM, and Worship and Music. Christian Education will be kicking off a new year of Wonderful Wednesday during the upcoming week. WELCA is planning a congregational dinner on Reformation Sunday and they have set the date for the WELCA/LMM Christmas dinner for December 3. LMM is planning the annual Fish Fry for November 5. And the Worship and Music team has recommended leaving our Covid Policy as it currently is due to an increase of Covid variant cases in the area.
- Regarding our Social Ministry and Food Pantry programs, Kevin noted that all bills have been paid for 2022 and the balance in the account is approximately \$3,400. This is enough funds to continue the program for the next three months, or basically through the end of the year.

There being no further business, the meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.
