From Your Pastor:

This past week I met via Zoom with the other interim pastors from the South Carolina Synod. After hearing some of their stories and some of the challenges our bishop's office is facing, I'm so thankful to be serving at Good Shepherd! The feisty political climate of the past several years has spilled over into many other aspects of everyday life. People are less civil with one another. Congregations with older membership profiles tend to be more conservative than their younger pastors. In South Carolina it has led to many difficult church relationships. How sad it is that people cannot listen to others with differing perspectives, learn from one another, and grow to appreciate the diversity that God has given us. Respect seems a lost art. In one congregation the council was even bullying their retired interim pastor----a very gracious and gentle man totally undeserving such treatment. I don't expect a church community to be devoid of differing opinions----that is to be expected, and even welcomed. But as people of the gospel, we want to act toward one another as if Jesus were in our midst (which, by the way, he is!). I have no doubt that the current political and social climate will evolve as it always does. Again, I am ever so grateful that a spirit of kindness and care lives in this congregation.

Elsewhere in this newsletter my wife has offered her own note of thanks, but I want to express my deep appreciation for your celebration of my 50th ordination anniversary in July. I surprised myself with getting pretty emotional in reflecting on those years and my commitment to the highest of professional standards in this calling. I believe my sermon for that day is posted on the church website if you didn't get the chance to hear it. The dinner celebration was wonderful and I thank everyone who made the effort to participate.

In August we'll have some additional substitutes as I spend two weeks out in the mountains of Colorado. At almost 9,000 feet we'll enjoy the cool evenings and low humidity. I've served as the president of the board for a timeshare condo association for ten years now, so this is a working vacation as we inspect all the units, note needed repairs, plan refurbishments, and hold an annual meeting. We'll probably have a number of fresh trout meals along the way and enjoy great board member friends in this work.

For Good Shepherd, August is a quieter month, though we'll be gearing up for fall and school will start back already mid-month. Your call committee is eagerly waiting for names from the synod and will be doing some interview preparation. The women are on break but the men will be meeting as usual. Enjoy those last days of summer and remember----the church is air conditioned and here every week!

Choir is on summer break until September.


